### PRESS NOTE

**Panchkula, the 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2018:** Dr. Dalip Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana stated that the election programme for the conduct of the General Elections of Gram Panchayat Sambalkha, Block Ladwa, District Kurukshetra and Bye elections on 409 vacant seats which includes 380 Panches, 21 Sarpanches of Gram Panchayat, 7 Members Panchayat Samitis & 1 member Zila Parishad has been issued today i.e. on 11.01.2018. The poll for these elections shall be held on 04.02.2018. The Election programme in this respect is as under:

8.	Date on which the list of contesting candidates shall be pasted.	27.01.2018 (immediately after the allotment of symbols)
9.	Date on which the poll, if any, shall be held.	04.02.2018 (Sunday)
10.	Timing of the poll	Between 8.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M.
11.	Counting of votes	i). Immediately after the close of poll. ii). In case of repoll, the Commission may change the date and time of counting of votes.

2. He further stated that according to the above mentioned programme, Nomination papers for the election to Panches and Sarpanches of Gram Panchayats shall be filed and received at the concerned Gram Panchayat Headquarter and that for the members of Panchayat Samitis and Zila Parishad shall be filed and received at the concerned Block Headquarter by the Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer. The scrutiny of the nomination

papers shall be taken up by the Returning Officers only. The votes for these elections shall be given by recording of votes by voting machines [Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs)].

3. He further stated that the counting of votes for all the elections shall be held at all the polling stations on the same day, but before starting counting, the Returning Officers would ensure that voting in all the polling booths under their control have been completed.

4. He further stated that a candidate filing the nomination paper for contesting the election of the seat of Panch, Sarpanch, Member Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad shall have to deposit an amount in Government Treasury or Sub Treasury or with the respective Returning Officer in cash, as under, as the case may be:-

Seat	General	SC/BC
Panch	Rs.100/-	Rs.40/-
Sarpanch	Rs.200/-	Rs.100/-
Member Panchayat Samiti	Rs.300/-	Rs.150/-
Member Zila Parishad	Rs.400/-	Rs.200/-

5. He further stated that the directions are being issued to all the Deputy Commissioners –cum-District Election Officers to give wide publicity to the above programme by munadi in villages, issue of press notes and other handouts and also by inserting paid advertisements in the two local news papers and through electronic media, so that more and more people may come to cast their vote and elect the members of Panchayati Raj for strengthening the democracy at grass root level.

6. Dr.Singh also said that NOTA(None of the above) option will be used in the elections of Sarpanch, member Panchayat Samiti and member Zila Parishad so that voters who come to the polling stations and decide not to vote for any candidate in fray, are able to exercise their right not to vote with maintaining their right of secrecy.

7. He further stated that any person whose name is not included in the voters list/electoral rolls of the concerned Gram Panchayats, may apply to the Deputy Commissioner concerned alongwith prescribed fee not later than four days from the date of publication of election programme.

8. Dr.Dalip Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana further appeals to all concerned voters to participate to elect the Members of Panchayati Raj Institutions for strengthening the democracy at grass root level.
