

**STATE ELECTION COMMISSION, HARYANA
S.C.O. NO.16-17, SECTOR-20 D, CHANDIGARH.**

NOTIFICATION

No. SEC/E-III/2000/3641

Dated:- 01.03.2000

Whereas the time schedule for holding General elections to Panchayats i.e. Panches and Sarpanches of Gram Panchayats and Members of Panchayats Samitis and Zila Parishads in three phases was issued by the State Election Commission vide notification No SEC/E-III/2000/3403, dated 23.2.2000, which was later on modified vide Commission's notification No. SEC/E-III/2000/3583, dated 25.2.2000 to hold these elections in two phases i.e. on 22nd March, 2000 and 29th March, 2000.

2. And whereas since the Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani had issued the detesheet for Senior Secondary Certificate Annual Examinations March, 2000 to be held from 7th March, 2000 to 29th March, 2000 vide its programme dated 5.2.2000, the Financial Commissioner & Secretary to Government Haryana, Education and Language Department, Chandigarh, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Chandigarh and Secretary, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani were requested vide Commission's letter No. SEC/E-III/2000/3607, SEC/E-III/2000/3608 and SEC/E-III/2000/3606, dated 25.2.2000 respectively to postpone the examinations scheduled to be held on 22nd March, 2000 and 29th March, 2000 and make available the school buildings on these two days for the conduct of poll as most of the polling stations notified by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer (Panchayat) in the State are located in these School Building.

3. And whereas, the State Government in the Administrative Departments of Development and Panchayat Department and Education and Language Department vide their memo No. E-I/2000/Spl dated 28.2.2000 and Endorsement dated 28.2.2000 respectively have informed that the examination schedule of Haryana Education Board has already been fixed and published and in addition the 8th Class Examination which are held in centralized manner have also been finalized, and if the dates of Panchayat elections are kept on 22nd March, 2000 and 29th March, 2000 it would dislocate the holding of examinations very much. State Government in these two Administrative Departments had accordingly requested for changing the polling dates of Panchayat elections from 22nd and 29th March, 2000 to any Sunday and some other working day. Keeping in view the fact that almost all the polling stations as notified by the Deputy Commissioners-cum-District Election Officers (Panchayat) are located in these school buildings, it is not possible to hold the Panchayat Elections unless the school buildings are made available to be used as polling stations for holding these elections.

4. And whereas in view of the above position the State Election Commission, Haryana has now decided to hold the General Panchayat Elections in the State in two phase i.e. on 12th March, 2000 and 16th March, 2000 instead of on 22nd March, 2000 and 29th March, 2000 earlier notified.

5. And now in exercise of powers vested in me under Sub-Section (2) of Section 212 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, I, T.D.Jogpal, State Election Commissioner, Haryana hereby prescribe, in the modification of the notification No. SEC/E-III/2000/3403, dated 23.02.2000 and notification No. SEC/E-III/2000/3583, dated 25.02.2000 that polling in respect of first phase will now be held on 12th March, 2000 (Sunday) from 8.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. and polling

in respect of second phase shall be held on 16th March, 2000 (Thursday) from 8.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. in all the blocks of the districts as per details given below:-
