**ORDER**

No.SEC/2E-II/2017/2240

Dated: 24.08.2017

The General Elections of Zila Parishad, Jind were held in January, 2016 and the results of the elected candidates were declared on 28.01.2016.

2. As per provisions contained in the Haryana Panchyati Raj Election Expenditure (Maintenance and Submission of Accounts) Order, 1996, every candidate contesting election to the post of Member of Zila Parishad shall have to maintain day to day election expenditure account in accordance with the procedure laid down in paras 4, 5 and 6 of these orders and shall have to lodge his account of election expenses within 30 days from the date of declaration of result of the election in the prescribed format with the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer(Panchayat) or any other officer as specified by the Commission. The total of the expenditure shall not exceed such amount as may be notified by the State Election Commission from time to time.

3. Para 11 of these orders provides that if the State Election Commission is satisfied that a person --

- (a) has failed to lodge an account of election expenses, within the time and in the manner required by or under this Act, and
- (b) has no good reason or justification for the failure, the State Election Commission shall, by order published in the Official Gazettee, declare him to be disqualified and may such person shall be disqualified for a period of three years from the date of the order.

4. The Commission, vide its notification No. SEC/2E-II/2015/5782, dated 03.06.2015 prescribed the limit of expenditure of Rs. 2,00,000/- that may be incurred by a contesting candidate or his authorized agent in connection with election of Member Zila Parishad.

5. As reported by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer, Jind through his letter No. 6468/Panchayat, dated 16.09.2016, 102 contesting candidates of Zila Parishad, Jind failed to submit their election expenditure statement within the prescribed time. The Commission had served a show cause notice upon them to explain as to why they should not be disqualified on account of non submission of

election expenditure account within the prescribed period. I had given an opportunity of personal hearing to 26 candidates in my office chamber on 16.08.2017 in the interest of justice. None was there to represent the Deputy Commissioner, Jind.

6. The candidates mentioned below at Sr.No.1, 2 and 3 responded to the show cause notice but did not appear in person. The remaining four candidates appeared and had submitted their submissions explaining the reasons for non submission of their election expenditure statement:-

During the course of personal hearing, the candidates mentioned at Sr.No. 4, 5, 6 and 7 had submitted their election expenditure statement. The reply as well as expenditure statements of all these candidates have been got examined and found to be within the expenditure limit prescribed by the Commission. I have gone through the submissions made by them and the facts available on the record. Taking a lenient view, I order to accept election expenditure statement of the above mentioned seven candidates.

7. The following candidates did neither respond to the show cause notice nor appeared before me:-

Therefore, it can be concluded that the above mentioned nineteen candidates have nothing to say in the matter. Hence, they deserve to be disqualified. I, Dr. Dalip Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana, in exercise of powers vested under Article 243K of the Constitution of India and Section 212 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and all other powers enabling in this behalf hereby order that the nineteen candidates mentioned in para 7 be disqualified for being chosen as, and for being a member of Panchayats i.e. Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad for a period of three years from the date of this order.

8. I further direct that a copy of this order be sent to all the candidates mentioned in para 6 and 7 above through Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer, Jind.
